Easter Mobile

1. Print the pages on regular paper or cardstock and cut out the pieces. Be sure to leave the pieces attached at the gray line.
2. Cut a piece of fishing line, ribbon, string, or twine as long as you would like your mobile to be.
3. Tape the top end of your string to a flat working surface to hold it steady. Remember to leave some room at the top so you can tie your mobile to the object it will hang from later.
4. Choose your first piece and fold it so the design is two-sided. Open the piece up again and lay it down so the white sides face up. Lay the string directly in the middle of each piece (see diagram below) and tape it in place. Cover the piece in glue or double-sided tape, then close the piece on top of the string so the design of the piece is two-sided.



5. Repeat step 4 with as many Easter pieces as you'd like to create a unique Easter mobile!
